2021 Parents and Campers:

The first day we recommend that the camper bring with them the items listed below to put into their cubbies. If they bring a carry-in bag, we ask that the parents take it home with them if it does not fit into their cubby.

Everything that comes to camp needs to be labeled with your child's name on it.

- Swimsuit and Towel (goggles are optional)
- Swim floats or Life Jackets for the non-swimmers
- Sunblock and Insect Repellent with Deet (optional Deet)
- Springtime Jacket (remember to label)
- Tennis Shoes that are comfortable and fit secure to the foot for "Everyday" activities
- Socks
- Your camper should wear their yellow or blue shirt to camp every day they attend (please label).

Your child will receive them the first day of day camp, provided the \$25 registration fee is paid. If you would like to purchase additional camp shirts, they are available at \$10.00 each.

Reminder, payment is due on Monday morning of the week that your camper is attending or the first day of the week your camper is scheduled. Payment can be made via check or credit card (Visa and Mastercard) and should be given to the day camp administrator, unless otherwise notified. If paying by check, please note in the memo section the child's full name. The total tuition per child is \$160.00 per 3 days a week (5-11); \$185 per 3 days a week (12-14, activity fee included); \$205.00 per week for children 5-6 and \$195.00 per week for children 7-11. Adventure Camp tuition for teens 12-14 is \$235.00 per week (\$210.00 tuition, \$25.00 activity fees).

For campers taking the bus from Deforest, Waunakee, or Middleton, please remember you need to be on time for both pick up and drop off. Bus vouchers are available on the website or from the counselor on the bus. Payment for bus service is due when the weekly tuition is due. Bus service is \$21.00 for part time (3 days) or \$35.00 per full week per child. **No adjustments to these charges will be made for times when your child will not ride.**

If any camper has medication, please give to the camp administrator upon checking your child in. Medication should not be kept in cubbies. We will make sure that the appropriate person receives and administers the medication. We must be sure that the Administration of Medication form is completed, and the directions are printed on the medication label from the pharmacy. Medication needs to be in the appropriate medication bottle. Please note other requirements stated on the Authorization to Administer Medication Form.

If your child comes between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 a.m., the children do have the option of playing games/activities, using the jumping pillow (ages 7-14), or watching a movie that we play in the back room. These movies are typically G and PG rated.
